We have denied Your Spirit by refusing spiritually gifted people to serve in ministry, but instead, we have indoctrinated them by sending them to our exclusive seminaries to prepare people for what we call “ministry” by our design (Ephesians 6:19).

We have stored up riches in our churches through properties and resources, which You told us not to do (Matthew 6:19).

We have used human exaltation by using terms and titles, the use of which You forbade (Matthew 23:17).

We have not been promoting Your kingdom, but merely promoting our church (Matthew 6:33).
